Dental Care for a Child Patient with Congenital Insensitivity to Pain with Anhidrosis

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The authors experienced buccal capsule care of a child patient with congenital insensitivity to pain with anhidrosis.

Attaching a double-layered plate after the eruption of deciduous molars was found to be effective to prevent the bite on the lingual borders.
